Hoopers is a fun dog sport that is suitable for dogs and owners of all ages and fitness levels.

Dogs navigate a course of hoops, barrels and tunnels with the same pace and excitement as agility, but without the wear and tear of jumping. The equipment is at ground level, so no jumping or climbing is involved and courses are flowing with no tight twists or turns, thus making it more accessible for both young dogs and old dogs.

Hoopers is focused on the ability of dog and owner to work together as a team.
