## CLASSES

- CLASS 1** Agility - Combined grades 1 - 4, and 5 - 7  
**CLASS 2** Jumping - Combined grades 1-4, and 5-7  
**CLASS 4** Steeplechase - Combined grades 1-4, and 5-7 (there will be NO weaves in this class)

All classes will be run over 5 heights :- large 60cm, Intermediate 50cm, medium 40cm, small 30cm (and micro 20cm for small dogs at **ANYSIZE/VETERAN** (see below)).

For dogs that cannot jump at their normal height for whatever reason, you will be allowed to run your dog at lower than their normal, you will still run within the same classes but be scored separately – as **ANYSIZE/VETERAN**.

**Please indicate on the entry form if you wish to run at a lower height.**

Please be at the ringside ready to run at your correct height.

(Please note that the A frame, dog walk and see-saw will remain at full height for all sizes)

Each class will be run as one class over the different heights but scored into the combined grades for each height; note – Large and Intermediate results will be combined, and those jumping at a lower height combined as Anysize.

**Non-Poodle NFC** to accommodate **members of PTC** who have entered a poodle for competition on the day and who may also have dogs of other breeds; non-poodles may run Not For Competition in all classes. Please indicate “non-poodle NFC” on the entry form.

## AWARDS

All classes will be run with combined placings for large & intermediate, separate placing for medium and small dogs with the exception of those running at a lower height ie **ANYSIZE/VETERAN** whose results will be combined for each class.

Trophies to at least 1<sup>st</sup> and rosettes to at least 10% of class entry for each size.

### Classifications

**Grade 1** Open to owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a minimum of 2 first places at Grade 1 at K.C. licenced agility shows, at least 1 of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of grade 1 are not eligible for this class.

**Grade 2** Open to dogs which are not eligible for grade 1 or have elected to progress on points from grade 1 and are not eligible for grades 3,4,5,6 or 7.

**Grade 3** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 2 first places at Grade 2 at licenced Kennel Club agility shows, one of which must be an agility (not jumping) class or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and dogs not eligible for grade 2,4,5,6 or 7

**Grade 4** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 3 first places at grade 3 at K.C. licensed agility shows, 2 of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class or have elected to progress on points from grade 3 at K.C. and are not eligible for grades 2,3,5,6 or 7.

**Grade 5** Open to dogs have gained a minimum of 4 first places at grade 4 at K.C. license agility shows, 2 of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for grades 2,3,4,6 or 7

**Grade 6** Open to all dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at grade 5 at K.C. licensed agility shows, 2 of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class and are not eligible for grades 2,3,4,5 or 7

**Grade 7** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 5 first places at grade 6 at K.C. licensed Agility shows, 3 of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) and are not eligible for grade 2,3,4,5 or 6

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Entry Fees: PTC Members £5 per dog per class, £4.50 for non-poodle NFC.
2. Non-Members £5.50 per dog per class
3. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2026 Show are not eligible.
4. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
5. Non competing entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over.
6. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
7. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. Not attached by a ring.
8. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
9. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
10. Kennel Club standard marking regulations apply.
11. Height of hurdles will be 60cm for large dogs, 50cm for intermediate dogs, 40cm for medium dogs and 30cm for small dogs. A micro height of 20cm will also be available.  
Contact equipment will be at normal regulation height.
12. The height limit for dogs.
  - a. Large Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 500mm at the withers
  - b. Intermediate Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 430mm and measuring 500mm or under at the withers
  - c. Medium Dog classes - For dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers
  - d. Small Dog classes – For dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers.
13. Withdrawal of dogs from Competition:  
A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Show if it is:-
  - a. A bitch which is in season.
  - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d. Of such temperament or so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
14. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to 8th June 2026) shall be counted when entering for any class. The dog will then be moved into the appropriate grade. **For this charity show, this only applies for dogs moving from grade 4 to grade 5.**
15. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped, addressed envelope submitted to the show secretary within 1 month of the show date.
16. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.

17. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.

18. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or their authorised agent in accordance with provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees.

19. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease – No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete

20. Animals in Event

No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the Lune Valley General Committee. However, at the discretion of the Lune Valley show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be permitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.

21. Any person failing to clean up after their dog or dogs, driving or riding at excessive speed or behaving in an aggressive manner will be asked to leave the show

22. All dogs will be entered at this show at their owner's risk and whilst every care will be taken, no liability will be accepted for any loss, damage or injury, however caused, to dogs, persons or property at this show.

23. All proceeds from the show will be given to a canine based charity as selected by the Poodle Training Club Committee

### **DIRECTIONS TO VENUE**

From North and South leave M6 at Junction 36. Follow signs for A65 to next roundabout. Turn left towards Kendal A65. When you enter Crooklands take the left turn for Milnthorpe B6385 opposite the Crooklands Hotel. Follow the B6385 for approx 1/2 mile and the show ground is on your right. Venue will be signposted.
